None – our costs are part of our service model and typically the responsibility of the developer. We have been contacted by several dairies, but none have contracted with us directly (yet). But our service model has our company carrying all the capital costs associated with the trucking operation. The project owns gas loading equipment that is part of the larger anerobic digester infrastructure budget and varies by location, farm size and gas output.
